

**Bucktail Lake Association Annual Meeting Minutes**  
**Home of Kris and Tom Yungdahl**  
**May 26, 2024**

President Tom Yungdahl called the meeting to order at 1:04 p.m.

**Roll Call:** A total of 21 of 39 lots were represented (54%), constituting a quorum (40%).

**Minutes:** The 2023 minutes were approved. Motion by Michele Meister, second by Brent Driewer.

**Treasurer's Report:** Karen Emerson reported a current balance of \$13,154.40 combined in checking and savings. A printed financial report for the year was distributed. Dues for 2024 are \$700. Dues of \$11,700.00 to Summerwood are due July 1. This is an increase of \$50 per lot beginning in 2024.

**Summerwood Report:** Rick Martinsen and Doug Sterup reported the new well has been installed. The power company has asked that trees be trimmed on all lake roads. Rick trimmed the trees by the gas pump. No changes to gate hours or type of gate. Reminder that golf carts must be marked with lake and lot number, even rentals. Watch for violations of golf cart rules and report them. Drivers under 14 are not to drive without an adult. Speed limit for golf carts is 20 mph.

**Water Quality:** Tom Yungdahl stated he will continue with the same treatment this year. The enzymes will be going in soon. Aerators are all running. The lake water seems to be in good condition. Tom reminded all to use low phosphate fertilizer and detergent and keep lawn clippings out of the lake. If you have seaweed, rake it out and use copper sulfate. Tom will get prices on restocking the lake. Crappie population seems low. Tell Tom what type of fish you want. Yungdahl reminded everyone of the danger of zebra mussels and the need to clean your watercraft before putting it in the lake and wait at least ten days if your craft has been in another lake or body of water.

Thanks to Rod Pollard for continuing to maintain our roads.
